

## Access Justice Brooklyn's Homeowner Assistance Program provides the following services:

- Direct legal representation and brief assistance
- Financial counseling

## We have three walk-in clinics in Kings County Supreme Court for homeowners seeking assistance related to foreclosure:

The <u>Friend of the Court</u> Program assists unrepresented individuals in foreclosure cases every Thursday, currently operates in-person and virtually.

The <u>Foreclosure Legal Assistance Group (FLAG) Program</u> provides homeowners entangled in foreclosure litigation with essential information about New York's unique foreclosure process and helps them understand their rights and options every Tuesday & Wednesdays from 2:30–3:30 PM at Kings County Supreme Court, Room 360. We also staff the Kings County Supreme Court <u>Foreclosure Clinic</u> every Friday from 10:00 AM–1:00 PM.

Addtionally, in partnership with the <u>Office of Administrative Trials and Hearings (OATH)</u> and Brooklyn Law School, the Homeowner Representation Project provides representation for the day to homeowners in Department of Buildings matters every Monday from 8:45 AM–1:00 PM, currently telephonically.
