

HOMEOWNER ASSISTANCE



Access Justice Brooklyn's Homeowner Assistance Program provides the following services:

- Direct legal representation and brief assistance
- Financial counseling
- Community outreach and legal education

We have three walk-in clinics in Kings County Supreme Court for homeowners seeking assistance related to foreclosure:

The Friend of the Court Program assists unrepresented individuals in foreclosure cases every Thursday, currently operates in-person and virtually.

The Foreclosure Legal Assistance Group (FLAG) Program provides homeowners entangled in foreclosure litigation with essential information about New York's unique foreclosure process and helps them understand their rights and options every Tuesday & Wednesdays from 2:30–3:30 PM at Kings County Supreme Court, Room 360. We also staff the Kings County Supreme Court Foreclosure Clinic every Friday from 10:00 AM–1:00 PM.

Additionally, in partnership with the Office of Administrative Trials and Hearings (OATH) and Brooklyn Law School, the Homeowner Representation Project provides representation for the day to homeowners in Department of Buildings matters every Monday from 8:45 AM–1:00 PM, currently telephonically.
